TO ALL SAILORS WHEREVER YE MAY BE

and to all Mermaids, Sea Serpents, Whales, Sharks, Porpoises, Dolphins, Skates, Eels, Suckers, Lobsters, Crabs, and other Living Things of the Sea. GREETINGS: Know ye, that on this 15th day of September 1943, in Latitude 0000 and Longitude XXXX there appeared within Our Royal Domain the U.S.S. GEORGE WASHINGTON, bound southward over the Equator and for unknown destination. BE IT REMEMBERED: That the said Vessel, Officers, Crew and MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES thereof have been inspected and passed on by Ourselves and Our Royal Staff, AND BE IT KNOWN: By all ye sailors, Marines, and Landlubbers who may be honored by his presence, that Sergeant Harold P. 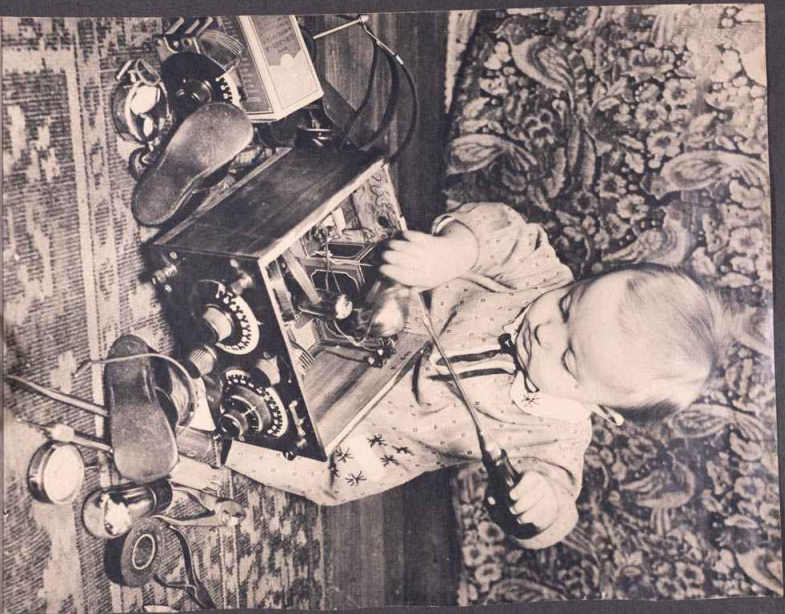
