If range cattle are sought, whether stock cows or stocker steers, he should have ample feed to carry the number of cattle thru the winter in good shape, and also have his grass for the coming year with assurance of plenty of water if the cattle be steers, the quality, the age, the number, and the flesh the cattle are carrying at time of inspection, also the weight and brand should be given in his report, and from what section of country whether his security is ample, his morals should be mentioned, good or bad.

20. State the usual diseases and other conditions that affect the value of the kinds of livestock that you are qualified to inspect for loan purposes:

Abortion in breeding stock, black leg, in young stock up to 2 years, pink eye, cancer eye, it is important to know from what part of the country cattle are to be shipped from on account of different climates, then there is a shipping fever, cattle shipped from a high altitude into a low one won do much good.
