**SUMMARY OF DOCTRINE HELD BY THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH.**

1. **ONE GOD;** infinite, eternal and unchangeable in His being, wisdom, power, holiness, justice, goodness and truth, subsisting in mysterious and eternal trinity—Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

2. **ONE WORD;** the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, all given by inspiration of God, and our only infallible rule of faith and practice.

3. **ONE CONDEMNATION;** there being no difference, for all have sinned and come short of the glory of God, because the carnal mind is enmity against God.

4. **ONE SAVIOUR;** the Lord Jesus Christ, God manifest in the flesh, the power unto salvation from sin and endless death, by atoning expiatory sacrifice, thru faith.

5. **ONE ATONEMENT FOR SIN;** made by Jesus Christ in His obedience unto death, sufficient for all, adapted to all, taking every legal obstacle out of the way of all, and on these grounds to be offered to all.

6. **ONE SPIRIT;** God, the Holy Spirit, thru whose sovereign agency in regeneration, the soul, dead in sin, is made alive in Christ, and thru whose sovereign agency in sanctification, the soul is changed more and more into the divine image from glory to glory.

7. **ONE LIFE;** the life hid with Christ in God—the eternal life, begun when a sinner believes, and assured forever thereafter by the effectual and sovereign grace of God; so that once given this eternal life, no believer shall ever perish.

8. **ONE CHURCH;** which is Christ's body, all the members of which, God hath from the beginning chosen to salvation thru sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth.

9. **TWO SACRAMENTS,** and only two, as ordained by Christ—Baptism and the Lord's Supper. Baptism being a sacrament wherein we have "sign and seal of ingrafting into Christ, of remission of sins by His blood, and regeneration by His Spirit;" and the Lord's Supper being a sacrament wherein "the Lord's death is showed forth," and the worthy receivers are, by faith, "made partakers of His body and blood, to their spiritual nourishment and growth in grace."

10. **ONE JUDGMENT;** when the dead, small and great shall stand before God, and every man shall be judged according to his works; and the wicked shall go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into life eternal.

**HOW TO BECOME A MEMBER OF THIS CHURCH BY LETTER.** Write to the pastor or officers of the church where you are a member requesting a letter of dismissal to "THE CALVARY PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH" of Wichita, Kan. (It is important in requesting letters of dismissal from a church to state the church to which you wish your letter issued.) Present your letter to the pastor or any member of the session.

**BY PROFESSION.** If you wish to unite with this church on profession of faith, it is necessary for you to meet with the session of the church. All they wish to be assured of is your earnest desire to receive Christ.

readily grant letters of dismission to any EVANGELICAL church. In requesting letters of dismission, please remember to state to what church you wish your letter presented. Unless so stated we have no authority to issue letters of dismission.

If you remove outside the bounds of this church and wish to retain your membership with this church, you ought in all fairness to yourself and the church keep in touch with this church by an occasional letter to the session of this church, and assist in the support of this church according to your ability.

This church must pay an ASSEMBLY TAX for all members reported as on the active roll, and presbytery apportion the benevolences expected from this church according to the active roll. For the members who are loyal to the church to make up the deficiency caused by the few who have not the welfare of the church to heart is unfair.

**THE RESERVED ROLL.** Because of removals where letters are not requested, and failure to support the church by attendance or financial assistance when such support is possible, the names of such members are placed on the RESERVED ROLL. They are not reckoned as active members of the church, and are not reported to presbytery. The names of such members may be restored to the active roll by giving evidence of their having the welfare of the church to heart.

#### BY-LAWS

Adopted at the Annual Congregational Meeting March 30th, 1916.

#### CONGREGATIONAL MEETINGS.

(a) All Congregational Meetings of the Calvary Presbyterian Church shall be constituted by the persons whose names are recorded on the active roll of the Church, or whose names appear on the Church Treasurer's books as contributors to the general expenses for the then current year; and all such are entitled to a voice and to vote upon all questions, except the vote for Elders, which shall be cast only by the members of the Church.

(b) The Annual Congregational Meeting shall be held on the first Thursday following the last Sabbath of March of each year at the Church at 7:45 P. M., the first fifteen minutes to be spent in devotional service.

(c) Special meetings shall be called on vote of the Session at any time the Session considers that there is business requiring the action of the Congregation. It shall be the duty of the Session to call a special meeting when requested to do so in writing by at least a majority of the members of the Church. Only such business as is stated in the "Call" for a special meeting shall be transacted at said special meeting.

(d) Notice of all Annual and Special Meetings shall be read from the Pulpit on at least each of the two Sabbaths immediately preceding such meetings. Notice of adjourned meetings shall be read from the pulpit on at least one Sabbath immediately preceding such adjourned meeting.

(e) Two Elders, two Trustees, and at least eleven members of the Church shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

(f) The Elective Officers of the Congregational Meeting are, a Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer, who shall be elected at the Annual Meeting, and shall hold office for one year or until their successors are elected. The Clerk of the Session shall be ex-officio Clerk of all Congregational Meetings.

(h) All Special and Adjourned Meetings shall be opened and closed with prayer.

**OFFICERS OF THE CONGREGATIONAL MEETING**

(a) The Chairman shall preside at all meetings of the

Congregation except when the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church, U. S. A., requires that an Ordained Minister shall preside. In the absence of the Chairman the Vice-Chairman shall preside, and if both be absent, the Clerk or any member of the Session shall convene the meeting, and proceed to the election of a Chairman Pro Tem.

(b) The Clerk shall keep a complete record of all meetings of the Congregation, and shall receive and file written reports of all departments of the work of the Church.

(c) The Treasurer shall receive all funds of the Church, except funds for benevolent purposes, which he shall deposit in a bank or banks designated by the Trustees, in his official title as "Treasurer", and shall disburse the same only on vote of the Trustees. He shall be the Custodian of all legal papers and documents of the Church, which he shall keep in a safety deposit box. The Treasurer shall also furnish each member of the Church and Congregation a quarterly financial statement of his or her account with the Treasurer; a summary of receipts and disbursements for the quarter, and an exhibit of the financial status of the Church.

**THE SESSION**

(a) At least six Elders shall constitute the Session, who shall serve for a term of three years, one-third being elected by ballot at each Annual Congregation Meeting.

(b) The Session shall elect a Clerk who shall serve during the pleasure of the Session; and a Treasurer of Benevolent Funds who shall serve one year. The Clerk of the Session shall keep complete minutes of all meetings of the Session and Con-

gregation, and complete files of reports of all departments of the work of the Church.

(c) The Treasurer of the session shall receive all Benevolent Funds of the Church and deposit the same in a bank or banks designated by the Session, in his official title as "Treasurer of Benevolences", and shall disburse the same on vote of the Session.

(d) The Session shall hold regular monthly meetings, and shall transact all business in conformity with the "Government, Discipline and Worship" of the Presbyterian Church of U. S. A.

#### THE TRUSTEES

(a) Five Trustees shall be elected by ballot from the active roll of the Church at each Annual Congregational Meeting, who shall serve for a term of one year or until their successors are elected and qualified.

(b) Within ten days after their election, the Trustees shall meet and qualify by subscribing to the oath of office, required by the Statutes of the State of Kansas, for corporations, and shall organize by electing a Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Secretary.

(c) The Secretary shall keep complete Minutes of all meetings in a suitable record book.

(d) The Trustees shall hold regular monthly meetings.

(e) The Trustees shall have the management of the temporal affairs of the Church, including the Budget for current expenses. They shall also be responsible for the maintenance of all the property of the Church, but shall not sell or lease any of the real property except by vote of the Congregation, and shall rent or grant the use of the Church edifice and grounds

for purposes outside the regular work of the Church, in accordance with the "Government, Discipline and Worship" of the Presbyterian Church U. S. A.

(f) Vacancies occurring during the year among the Trustees shall be filled at a special meeting of the Congregation.

#### DEACONS.

Three or more Deacons shall be elected by ballot from the active roll of the Church at each Annual Congregational Meeting, who shall serve for a term of one year. They shall organize by the election of Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer. Their duties are primarily to look after and care for the temporal welfare of any in the Congregation and community who may be in need.

#### CHURCH COUNCIL.

The Session, Trustees and Deacons shall together constitute the Church Council, and shall hold meetings on call of the Pastor or Session for the consideration of questions pertaining to the welfare of the Church. The Pastor shall preside, but should he be absent the Council may elect a Chairman Pro Tem.

#### AUDITING COMMITTEE.

The Chairman of the Congregation shall appoint a standing Committee of three who shall have the power to make an audit of the books and files of the Treasurers at any time, and report the same to the Trustees.

#### AMENDMENTS

These By-Laws may be altered or amended by a two-thirds vote of those present at any Annual Congregational Meeting, or at any regularly called special meeting of the Congregation.
