BOOK REVIEW

"Receipt for an Inheritance"

The Making of a Family by Margery Frances Day Hanson Richard E. Hanson, Editor

This is a well planned and written book with many pactures. The 1740-1873 era deals with the Fleenors and Hopes on their Great Western Trek. The Migration of the German Fleenors, the marriage of Jacob William Fleenor and Mary Susannah Hope.

There are 100 years of descendants 1874-1974, Family Records, Brothers, Sistors. The grandchildren of Jacob and Mary Hope Fleenor, Directory and picture album. You will also find descendants of the brothers and sistors of Jacob and Mary.

You will find collateral lines, pictures and the Hanson Family. Epilogue (Receipt for an Inheritance), Appendix, Clippings, and excerpts, also, an early map of Lecompton, Kansas as remembered by Eldred Day.

Anyone doing research should look at this book, it has so many names and localities such as, Sterling, Kansas, Le Compton, Kansas, Lawrence, Kansas, Abilene, Kansas, Little River, Kansas, and Lyons, Kansas. It is a very well written and interesting book.

BOOK REVIEW WESTMORLAND COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA AREA KEY

Florence Clint, a genealogist and researcher saw the need for a guide which would help researchers, especially beginners, in their efforts in locating records. She felt it a great waste of time that each person should have to determine what records were available, where they were located, where were the maps, the histories, newspapers, cemeteries, and the like when it had been done so many times before. In 1970 the author published an "Area Key"for the state of Pennsylvania. It was designed to be used as an aid in locating records which pertained to the state in general. She has now published individual county "Area Keys" which include all available material for each county of Pennsylvania.

Westmorland County is described as a sort of "mother county" for many of the Western counties. The proximity to Allegheny County and to Pittsburgh is of importance to all genealogists as Pittsburgh developed rapidly and Westmorland became dependent upon this development. Therefore, the searcher should become acquainted with the Carnegie Library and the Historical Society of Western Pennsylvania in Pittsburgh as well as the Greensburg Public Library and Westmorland-Fayette Historical Society.

Contents of the book include a condensed history of the county, a short sketch of Westmorland County, and a comment on the value of the disputed "Morn Paters" for use in historical and genealogical research. (Vols. 1 and 2, no, no; Vol. 3, yes.) John White Geary was born in Westmorland County and became the first governor after the Civil War. He previously was a territorial governor of "bleeding Kansas" succeeding in stopping the bleeding before returning to Pennsylvania?

Types and dates of court house records are noted along with the hours and days the court house is open. The importance of the key to an index is explained. Six different systems are used in Pennsylvania of which only one is alphabetical. The Russel System is the most popular and an explanation is given.

Books available at the Westmorland Historical Society are listed. Also listed are those at the Carnegie Library in Pittsburg as well as library hours.

Other helps include maps, the locations of newspapers, cemetery lists, and photo copies of all the index cards for Westmorland County in the Dictionary Card Catalogue of the Salt Lake City Genealogical Library.

This book would be most helpful to one searching in Westmorland County and we highly recommend it.
