Up to now we haven't been able to find much for them and didn't know where to send them for the information they were requesting, but after spotting this gem of a suggestion in the Elgin Genealogical Society Newsletter October 1890 - The State Historical Society of Wisconsin owns the Circus World Museum. Their museum and research center, 415 Lynn St., Baraboo, Wisconsin 53913, has an index of 360,000 circus people (Can you believe that number!) They answer mail inquiries."

We would suggest that you also include a SASE with your inquiry.....

George I. GIRD informs us that a source for family history help might be The Steamship Historical Society of America, Inc. Passenger lists were printed and distributed to those on board many ocean crossings. Their collection is of random voyages. They also have information such as weight, size, life, etc., and photographs of many vessels. Address: University of Baltimore Library, S.S.H.S.A. (As we have noted in the preceding parts of this series, Pauline Stewart MASSEY graciously agreed to write this article with the complete understanding she would answer no questions or letters personally.)

As we promised you in Part II of our article, we will now tell you what can be found in a Courthouse: In the Department of Probate, one will find Wills and Estate Settlements. Wills were written by many of our ancestors. If one died without a will, then there should be an Estate Settlement, and in those papers there should be a paper listing the heirs. Sometimes the wills are copied in books, and sometimes everything is kept in numbered packets in boxes. These boxes are indexed. IF you are allowed to look in the boxes, BE VERY CAREFUL! Some contain many papers, and depending on the length of time they have been stored, may be very fragile.

I was lucky to find the packet of a great-great-grandfather who died in 1818. It contained his will, his wife's will, his wife's first husband's will and papers of settlement dating until 1842. There I had a good record of the family's progress during those years. Be sure you put everything in order. Have those papers copied if copiers are available, otherwise copy them exactly, noting paper number, packet number, box number, and name under which the packet is indexed.

A will can give much explicit information, or it may be "I give my all to Nancy." In this case one needs to go to other books to find out what the estate consisted of and how it was doled out.

Deeds are another source of valuable information. I address letters to Department of Land Records, as I have found in travel through the U. S. of A. that all Courthouses do not file their documents the same way. When you start on deeds, you will find there are two indexes, one Indirect, and the other Direct. I usually start with the Indirect - you will find the Volume and page number of the Deed Book you need. Indirect shows when your ancestor got the land. It may tell when he came to the county and where he came from. It also locates the land. Direct indexes refer you to the Deed your ancestor gave when he gave up the land. He may have sold it, willed it away, left it without a will, or given it to one of his children. So you may get a death date, a date of removal to a new state, or a new farm.

You will find a farm located thus: NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 21 T27S R18E. (Denoting Section 21, Township 27 South, Range 18 East). Go to the County Engineer's office (or write for a map) to get a road or plat map of the County. It will have the Sections on it. Ask the County Engineer to help you locate the Ranges and Townships, they are numbered at the edges of the map. When you have located that block, then look for Section 21 - they are also numbered within the sections. After you have the Section, you can easily locate the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$. I have never had to pay more than \$1.00 for a map, sometimes they have given the map to me, free.

You can see that cemeteries are marked on these maps with a T-shaped cross. There may be a cross close to the land you have located. If so, maybe some ancestor is buried there. One can also locate the nearest churches and find if any family records are there.

Do learn to use the books in the Courthouse yourself. Don't be a pest to the people who work there. There is usually very little room to work and may have

no chairs available. We take two folding chairs and small TV tables to use in case we need them. They are also handy in motels at night or for an impromptu picnic in the park when on an outing for research.

The Marriage Records are sometimes in the County Clerk's office, but since we have found them in many different offices, we now address our letters to Department of Marriage Records, Courthouse, the town and state. I usually copy all the marriages of the surname I am interested in. Eventually you may find where they fit in.

Keep an open mind as you work. A lady in New Mexico wrote to me some time ago for some information. I happened to have a magazine which told the ancestry of her great-grandfather's brother. She thanked me, but said she was not interested in her great-uncle's ancestors....she failed to see that brothers would have the same ancestors!

You say, "My grandparent's came from Europe about 1910 and I do not know where they came from. How do I go about finding out?" If it has been that recently, there should be some family members who might know. If not, maybe you can find their naturalization papers. If they were naturalized, it would have been at least five years after their entry into this country. The records should be at the District Court nearest to where they lived. Phone your own District Court and ask what District Court serves the area where they lived, or if it is in another state, write to the County Court and ask what District Court serves that area. Then you can go about trying to find if they were naturalized.

After you find where they came from, you might proceed through Church records if they were of any particular religious belief. I find that old encyclopedias have very good descriptions of towns. I have a set of Encyclopedia Britannica, 1882, which gives good descriptions of towns in Germany, France, etc. Once you have the description of the area, you could then write to the church of their faith in the nearest city. If they were not communicants of that church, maybe they can tell you what church did serve the town where your ancestors came from. I have known people who made contacts thus, and were able to hire a great deal of research done for a relatively small cost. I am not an authority on foreign research, but many of our genealogical Society members have been successful in their efforts. Perhaps we can persuade them to write an article of their successes in foreign research for a future issue.

There is also the matter of family legends. NEVER dismiss them as 'pipe dreams' or fabrications. The story may have been altered as it passed through the generations, but there is usually some truth in family stories, so use them. Don't dismiss them nonchalantly, they can be a clue for an entirely different approach if you become stymied in your research. Prove them either true, partly true, or false; however, keep in mind that female names change and a story which was on your Jones side may not be a Mary Jones story at all, but may be three generations back on the female line and belong to the Mary Smith family.

One friend who came to me knew nothing about the family except that the ancestor was a Calloway PATRICK and he 'rode with Sam Houston." I suggested she write to the Archives of Texas, Austin, Texas. In a few days she received a biography of Calloway Patrick which not only told of his deeds, but included his ancestors for several generations. It is not always this easy to get information, but in order to get information, the researcher has to work every avenue of approach.

Now what about the story which says your three times great grandfather served in the Revolution? There are several sources on that. One is the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) Patriot Index. This consists of one large book and three supplementary books. The last supplement brings the index to 1974. The remaining names will be found in the DAR magazines from that date under New Ancestor Lists. (These have been copied and the list is in our Society library.)

After you have the DAR list, look for your ancestor's name. It doesn't matter about the spelling - your name may be BROWN, but it may show up as BRAUN (German for Brown). Your ancestor's name may have been John, but it may show up here as Johann. Most people are very particular about the spelling of their names but chances are it has been altered some in the last 300 years, and even if it hasn't maybe the clerk who wrote it couldn't spell very well, or his writing was difficult to decipher.

If you find your ancestor's name in the Patriot Index, it will probably tell his wife's name, his birth and death dates and where he served. If you have found it, you may send \$2.00 to the Secretary General, U.S.D.A.R., 1600 D Street N.W., Washington, D.C., 20006. State ONLY that you wish to obtain the lineage sheet of: (copy exactly as in Index). Do not write a long letter. One sentence is enough. Make your check payable to: Treasurer General, N.S. DAR. You do not need an SASE with this letter. In a few days or two months, you should get the lineage sheet. You may be able to hook on somewhere. Take note of the proof given for each step. You may find that this isn't your ancestor at all, especially if there are several of the same name. You may find that this is your ancestor, but that the descent is not your line. Usually the children of the patriot are listed. This may help you.

There are other sources to refer to, but it is necessary that these be discussed at a future time.

RENO COUNTY, KANSAS: City of Abbyville

The railroad bought the right-of-way through this part of Reno County in 1873; however, Abbyville did not become a city until about 1886, and was named for Abigail McLEAN, daughter of grocer James McLEAN.

Some of the earliest families homesteading in and around the city of Abbyville were: James GAGNEBIN, Sr., 1870; Ephraim and Joseph BRIDGEMAN, 1872; John MARTIN, 1873; Isaac McIVER, 1873; W.A.ANDERSON, 1873; James DUNN, George C. CADE, 1873; James McLEAN 1873; Arion FRYREAR, 1873; Emzi DAVIDSON, 1873; Ely PALMATIER, 1874; S.S. MEAD, 1874; Arthur COOK, 1874; Charles FESLER; A.J. LENTZ, 1878; Ike KITZMILLER, 1885; Will BAKER, 1885; Joseph DELLENBACH, 1894; Henry DIXON, Peter DECK, Joshua DAVIS, Tom DUVAL, John DEVINE, plus families of BAGGS, BIRKET; CANFIELD, COFFMAN, FRASER, FOUNTAIN, and FREEMAN.

The first burial in the Westminster Cemetery was supposedly in 1861, although the oldest tombstone inscription to be found marks the grave of May E. WISLID, died July 4, 1868. The oldest tombstone found in the Abbyville Cemetery is that of Amos SALMON who died February 13, 1888, at the age of twelve years.

Thank you for printing in the Oct.-Dec. 1980 REGISTER my query about needing info on Lydia BENNETT of Bunker Hill, Russell Co., Kansas. In answer to this, the latter part of Nov., I received a letter from a fellow member, Mrs. Harold (Bernice) PEACOCK of Wichita, who had grown up in Bunker Hill and had known some of the BENNETT family. She also sent to us the name and address of Mrs. Sybel McCALEB and her daughter, Mrs. Darrell (Bobbie Jo) DEHLER at Emporia, Kansas. I wrote to them for any information they might have on Lydia BENNETT, my husband's mother, and any info on his older brother or sister....before I continue, refer to page 137 of the Oct-Dec. 1980 REGISTER.

But we hit Bingo, Jackpot, and Pot of Gold, all at one time: We do give you permission to print this story and the facts.

In the letter from Mrs. McCALEB and Mrs. DEHLER was additional information about my husband's family by birth, but also the name of his older sister, and this was the first time in his 59 years of life that he knew he had a sister. It also enclosed her phone number. His sister is Mrs. Leona WALKER of Oak Hill, Kansas. On Saturday evening, Dec. 27th, 1980, my husband called his sister and talked with her - as well as I did. We talked for 2½ hours! My husband, Glenn Daniel FISCHGRABE by adoption, Earl Ivan BENNETT by birth, has found his sister and 6 other sisters and 1 brother, and learned that he was one of 9 children. His sister, Leona, told us that in Bunker Hill is a small museum with a lot of family history in it, and also that he is Scotch-Irish and English and that there is a BENNETT family castle in Scotland. She also told us that he is a second cousin to Senator Bob DOLE of Kansas. Needless to say I'm sure you can understand our joy at the findings and information.

Our children and their spouses are also super excited about their last family - but new family at the same time. You have helped all of us with the finding and we just wanted you to know how grateful we are to you and to share this information with others who are looking for missing ancestors. Don't ever give up!!
