Levi Jackson HORLACHER and Vaneta Thomas HORLACHER have compiled a record of the descendents of Hans Michael HORLACHER and his wife Maria Veronica. It is written in an easily understood manner and contains a great deal of genealogical information making it possible to trace the ancestors of the persons included.

The book is completely indexed. To the knowledge of the authors, this is the only publication dealing with the HORLACHER family. There is a brief history of the HORLACHER" name and lists many variations of the name.

Hans Michael HORLACHER, his wife Maria Veronica, and daughter Maria arrived at the Port of Philadelphia, Province of Pennsylvania on the ship Pennsylvania Merchant from Rotterdam. They came from Germany, probably Wurttemberg. The Bennsylvania Merchant docked 10 September 1731 and the next day Hans Michael took the oath of allegiance to Pennsylvania. Thirtyone years later he passed the requirements and was certified as a natural born citizen of Great Britain and it is so recorded in the Pennsylvania Archives.

William Davis Kennedy was born in Nashville, Tenn, Nov. 8, 1830. When he was eleven months old his parents settled in Johnson County, Indiana, and there he grew up on his father's farm. He was married Oct. 9, 1858 to Susan M. Webb. And for five years they lived on a farm in this same community. They then migrated to Sullivan County, Mo.

On Nov. 10, 1861, Mr. Kennedy enlisted in Company G, 23rd. Infantry regiment, Missouri Volunteers and served 3 years in 'Army of the Cumberland, rising to rank of 1st. Sgt. Fought in battle of Shiloh, and was with Sherman in the March to the Sea. He was mustered out of service at St. Louis Nov. 18, 1864

Upon leaving the army, he returned to his home and family and lived in Missouri until 1877, when they moved to this community, purchased home  $3\frac{1}{2}$  mi. W. &  $1\frac{1}{2}$  mi. S. of Haven living there until 1907. when he moved to town.

Jan. 1910 his wife died, and since then he had lived with son Thomas K. Kennedy. He suffered an attack of ursemic poisoning which took him away.

He was the father of eleven children. Two died in infancy; one daughter, Mrs. Mary R. Taylor died at Galena, Ks. 19 years ago; one son Stephen A. died at Clayton, New Mexico 2 years ago. The other seven were present at time of his death: John M. of Eskridge, Ks.; David W. of Haven; James E., Haven; Mrs. M.C. Smith, Cherokee, Oklahoma; Wm. F., Haven; Thomas K.;, Haven and Woodward D, Macksville, Ks. One sister Mrs. Mary R. Richardson, Trafalgar, Ind. survives him. There are 18 grand children and 10 great grand children.

Funeral held from Haven M.E. Church at 2 o'clock. Interment at Laurel Cemetery

Jame E. Kennedy died Oct. 11, 1922: James E. Kennedy was born Mar. 29, 1861, Sullivan Co., Mo. and moved to Haven township, Reno County, Kansas with his parents in 1877, resiging here continuously up to his enlistment in the Spanish American war, Aug. 10, 1899 in the 32d U. S. Volunteers. He was Corporal of Company A and chief of scouts and the company barber. He was mustered out of service Apr. 17, 1901 after 1 yr. 8 mo. He returned to Haven where he lived till his death by accident Wednesday, Oct. 11, 1922.

He leaves 5 brothers and 1 sister: David W.; W.D.; of Hutchinson; Wm. F, Haven; Thomas K.; Lamar, Colo.; John M.; Topeka, Ks; and Mrs Ada R. Smith, Alva, Okla.

Funeral services were held in the Methodist Episcopal church. Interment in Mt. Lawn Cemetery, Sat. Oct. 14, 1922.

#### ORIGIN OF YOUR NAME

In early times most people bore only a first name. Along about the time of the Norman conquest of England, however, the nobility began to use the titles of their ancestral estates as surnames. The rest of the people followed the example, and proudly assumed the names of their trades, such as Smith, Baker, Miller, Clark (Clerk), and many more that you will recognize among the names of your friends today.

Other names show simple relationship of father and son. For instance, Wilson was originally William-his-son. Thompson and Johnson and many more were formed in the same way. Indeed, in almost every country you find names indicating this relationship.

The prefix O' in Ireland and Mac or Mc in Scotland has this meaning. That is, O'Hara means the son of Hara, and MacCarthy means the son of Arthur. The French word for son, "fils," was corrupted into Fitz. Thus, Fitzpatrick means the son of Patrick and Fitzgerald means the son of Gerald. The Welsh indicated this same thing by the word "ap." In this way David the son of Howell was called David ap Howell, which gradually became Powell. Ap Richard became Pritchard.

As people moved from one country to another they often became known by place names. A man from Scotland would be called "the Scot," and the surname Scott would be applied to his whole family. Wallace originally indicated a person who came from Wales.
