BOOK REVIEW

SOME MAGNA CHARTA BARONS' AND OTHER ROYAL LINEAGES, by Dorothy A. Sherman Lainson 226 pages.

Great lessons may be learned from a study of our ancestors, writes Dorothy Lainson in this detailed work. She points out that even now there may be a struggle "to re-establish our nation's democratic principles." Such struggles demand huge sacrifices by persons willing to pay the price to establish their rights.

It was just an experience under which King John of England was forced to grant the Magna Charta (Great Charter) to his people. John's oppressive rule and heavy taxation led to the acts which resulted in the Magna Charta. It was in 1214 that the Northern barons took up arms against their king. Mrs. Lainson publishes the preamble of the Charter and uses a few quotations, along with the background, which although brief is comprehensive and well worth reading.

This leads easily to a glossary of heraldry, interpretations of coats of arms and a list of symbols for different sons. Additional historical information is carried with the numerous lists of the Magna Charta Barons. The Alphabetical listings will be helpful to many students of ancestors -- not only to beginners but to many who have been following the avocation for years.

One needs to spend only a few minutes with this book to realize that this field is not new to the author -- to indicate she is well equipped by educational and actual work for the job. Her other compilations include four other works, dating from 1963. The current work has been donated to the Midwest Genealogical Society library by Ellen Hiatt.

"HOWARD CEMETERY" LAWRENCE CO ILLINOIS ALLISON PRAIRIE Near VINCIENNES INDIANA Submitted by Mrs Ross Kirkham

This is a very old Cemetery located upon a knoll, Howard Cemetery in on Beautiful Allison Prairie, it is about three miles Northwest of the Centervill Cemetery and the former location of the small village of Centerville. It is on a main road and when restoration is complete will be a real Historic spot in the County.

The Cemetery contains Revolutionary, Civil War and Black Soldiers. The first burial in the Cemetery was in the Adams Plot and the earliest grave was in 1838. The last burial was in 1902 that of the daughter of V & M B Inboden.

It seems as though many died young in the days of activity at Howard Cemetery. Pneumonia probably accounted for the deaths of the older people and tuberculosis presumably made great inroads with the younger people. Many infants failed to pass the second year.
